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Nurse diagnoses are based on data from the nurse assessment and allow the nurse to develop a care plan. The term care diagnosis is associated with three different concepts. This can refer to a clear second step in the care process, diagnosis. In addition, the diagnosis of nurses is applied to the label, when nurses assign meaning to the collected data, appropriately marked by the diagnosis of NANDA-I.
